#1 – God always calls those who are seeking.

**Jeremiah 29:13 – “You will seek me and find me when you seek after me with all your heart.”**

#2 – God never calls us to a short journey...or an easy one...

**- 1 Timothy 4:7 – “...train yourselves to be godly.”**

Title: “Bulls Eye Living”

**Ephesians 2:10 – “God our maker and in our union with Christ has created us for life of good works which He has already prepared for us to do.”**

**Proverbs 16 – “The Lord has made everything for His own purpose.”**

BULLS EYE LIVING defined: Living as if God were real and important to me.

- 1.) Bulls Eye Living makes my decisions clearer.
- 2.) Bulls Eye Living Gives my life Satisfaction.

**Ephesians 5:15-17 – “Pay close attention to how you live...Make good use of every opportunity you get...find out what the Lord wants you to do.”**

- 3.) Bulls Eye Living allows God to do His thing.

**Matthew 6:31-33 – “So don’t worry about having enough food or drink or clothing. Why be like the pagans who are so deeply concerned about these things? Your heavenly Father already knows all your needs, and he will give you all you need from day to day if you live for him and make the Kingdom of God your primary concern.”**

- 1.) God made you to know Him and to LOVE HIM. (faith)

**Matthew 22:38 – “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind. This is the first and greatest commandment.”**

- 2.) God mad you to become LIKE JESUS. (character)

**Romans 8:29 – “For from the very beginning, God decided that those who came to him...should become like his Son.”**

- 3.) God mad you to HELP OTHERS. (service)

**1 Peter 4:10 – “God has given each of you some special abilities; be sure to use them to help each other, passing on to others God’s many kinds of blessings.”**

- 4.) God made you to tell others ABOUT HIM. (mission)

**Acts 20:24 – “Life is worth nothing unless I use it for doing the work assigned me by the Lord Jesus-the work of telling others the Good News about God’s mighty kindness and love.**

Four Questions:

- 1.) **Faith:** How are you going to live?
- 2.) **Character:** Who are you going to be?
- 3.) **Service:** What are you going to do?
- 4.) **Mission:** What are you going to say and how are you going to say it?
